"Am I free to leave?"

Yes -> Leave.

No -> Asserts Your Rights...

Say **"I want to remain silent."**

- Your silence can never be used against you.
- One can assert this right anytime!
- If they ask I can give them my personal info.

Say **"I want to talk to a lawyer."**

- It means they need to stop asking me questions

Say **"I do not consent to any searches."**

(Consent vs warrant for probable cause)

They can only pat me down for a weapon.

If I'm arrested they can search me.

Still say "I do not consent to any searches".

Don't Forget, The Police Are Allowed To Lie, We Are Not.

Citizens cannot falsely identify themselves.

If I Get Arrested / Do Not Make A Statement

Do not talk to the police.
Anything you say can and will be used against you.
They want info on our group.
The police can lie about your statements.

"Any lawyer worth his salt will tell [a] suspect in no uncertain terms to make no statement to police under any circumstances." -Watts v. Indiana U.S. 49 (1949)

"If you take nothing else away from this essay, I want you to tattoo this onto your brain forever:

If a police officer is telling you something, it is probably a lie designed to gain your compliance.

Do not talk to cops and never, ever believe them. Do not "try to be helpful" with cops. Do not assume they are trying to catch someone else instead of you. Do not assume what they are doing is "important" or even legal. Under no circumstances assume any police officer is acting in good faith.

Also, and this is important, do not talk to cops."

If I get arrested and I'm in a police station, they are going to be friendly to get you talk. They are trained on getting you to talk with the READ system. They use tricks and lie. They are allowed to. They will keep working you and working you. Don't make a statement to the police. If you and a friend are arrested and in different rooms, DO NOT TALK. Your silence can never be used against you! The READ system, which stands for "Rapport, Empathy, Ask, and Develop," is a technique used by law enforcement to encourage defendants to communicate openly. It focuses on building rapport and understanding to facilitate a more productive dialogue during interrogations.

Calls in Jail are recorded. It can be used against you.

MIRANDA WARNING

1. YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT.
2. ANYTHING YOU SAY CAN AND WILL BE USED AGAINST YOU IN A COURT OF LAW.

6. (Not given) YOUR SILENCE CAN NEVER BE USED AGAINST YOU.
